Results: Home Venues are responsible for reporting the results of fixtures to the league.

You have three methods available. 1. Phone on the night. (Best time is just after the quiz is over).

2. E-mail on the night, when you get home! 3. Post the Card!

Either 1 or 2 are required. 3 is also required.

This way we can keep the scores updated and included in the following weeks envelopes!

SO, the AGM decided that if any home side fails to notify the results, by any means, by the Tuesday following the fixture, a 10 point penalty may be applied to that home teams score (once we find out what it was of course!). This is a discretionary penalty to be decided at the discretion of both the Chairman & the Results Secretary. Let's hope we never have to use it!
